- The pavilion has tables, grills, electricity, water and bathrooms. Bathroom hours: 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.
- 1-Day parking passes for guests must be purchased in advance. (50 max. per picnic).
- A caterer's pass is issued to cross the bridge in a vehicle (for drop-off and pick-up purposes). It is good for 15 minutes only. - **VEHICLE CANNOT PARK ON THE ISLAND AND MUST BE BROUGHT BACK TO THE PARKING LOT.** (Two passes maximum).
- Park curfews inside the park are from one hour after sunset to 5:30 a.m. Main land from 12:00 midnight to 5:30 a.m.
- For a ball field permit, please call Recreation Services at 977-5214.

If applicant represents an organization or group, he/she must be authorized to execute this application by said organization or group seeking the permit. Permit does NOT include guaranteed use of any ball fields in park, nor does it permit unauthorized vehicles in restricted areas.

## PARK REGULATIONS

The following are specifically prohibited or restricted:

1. Make loud or disturbing noises, including amplified music. \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)
2. Serve or consume intoxicating or alcoholic beverages except beer. \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)
3. Use glass bottles or containers of any kind. \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)
4. Light fires except in picnic grills or fireplaces placed by the city. \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)
5. Gas or propane grills. \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)
6. Use of moon-walks or inflatable. \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)
7. Park in designated areas between May 1<sup>st</sup>. and September 30<sup>th</sup> without a valid parking sticker. Permits are required at Cove Island Park, Cummings Park, West Beach, Southfield Park and Dorothy Heroy Park. \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)
8. Possess alcohol, including beer, after 9:00 p.m.
9. Wantonly damage or remove lawns, trees, shrubs, flowers, benches, bleachers, drinking fountains or any other property or equipment.
10. Discard paper, trash, rubbish, glass, crockery, or metal, except in containers provided by the City for such purposes, and no household debris at any time.
11. Have an unleashed animal except in a vehicle.
12. Peddle or sell goods, merchandise and food without a City License, and Office of Operations Permit.
13. Hold mass meetings or public assemblies except with a City Permit.
14. Drive a vehicle at speeds over 15 miles per hour or to park such vehicles except in areas designated for such purposes.
15. Wash or repair vehicles in the park.
16. Play ball or organized games except in areas plainly designated for such activity.
17. Bathe or swim in restricted areas.
18. Post signs on trees or other park property.
19. Disobey posted signs or warnings.
20. Drive or chip golf balls in a park.
21. Hunt, trap, or pursue wild life at any time on public park land.
22. Food or beverages on artificial turf.
