MYLC, bullying and schools in Stamford

“Members of the Mayor’s Youth Leadership Council (MYLC) are asking you to build on Connecticut’s new bullying law,” said Hannah Carlson at the November 22 meeting of the Stamford Board of Education.

“We ask that you expand the school district’s definition of bullying, and the regulations that go along with it, to include four forms of bullying: student on student, which the new law addresses; student on adult bullying; adult on student

bullying; and adult on adult bullying.”

Hannah continued. “The research we have read about school climate, school safety, academic achievement and job satisfaction points to the need for everyone in a school district to work together on these forms of bullying.

Members of the Mayor’s Youth Leadership Council are ready to help you come up with policies and regulations and protocols

that help eliminate bullying from the Stamford school district.”

The next activity in MYLC’s *School Climate Initiative* is a press conference on December 9 to recognize International Human Rights Day. The topic? Bullying.
