The panel continued deliberation on an advisory opinion request by Mr. Lyons regarding a potential conflict of interest under Section 19-13 of the City Code of Ethics. Mr. Lyons appeared before the panel to discuss his request.

Discussion ensued and the Board agreed to prepare a draft opinion, which after consideration and approval by the full Board, will be sent to Mr. Lyons. A copy of the final opinion will also be filed with the Town & City Clerk.

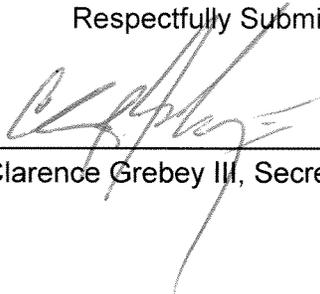
3. New Business

- The Board discussed guidance it plans to present to the Board of Representatives and Corporation Counsel concerning ambiguity or conflicting definitions in Section 19-9 of the current City Code.

- The Board reviewed the contents of the Board of Ethics Web site and made recommendations for additions, deletions, and amendments to the site.
- The Board agreed not to schedule a regular meetings for the month of August and instead set a preliminary next meeting date of July 24.

The motion was made, seconded, and carried, unanimously, to adjourn the meeting at 9:15 p.m.
