A regular meeting of the Stamford Police Commission was held on Monday, March 4, 2013 at 4:00pm at Stamford Police Headquarters.

Present at the meeting were Commissioner Mark Larobina, Commissioner Milton Thomas, II, Commissioner Frank Mercede and Commissioner Cheryl Palmer. Also present was Ex-Officio Chief Jonathan Fontneau. Commissioner Berkoff was absent from the meeting.

The meeting was called to order at 4:07pm by Commissioner Larobina.

Review of Minutes

Commissioner Mercede made a MOTION to accept the minutes of February 4, 2013 and seconded by Commissioner Thomas. All were in favor.
