Tim Curtin reported that the extension of the contract for Maintenance Services at Old Town Hall with AFB Construction Management Corp., which was approved at the Board's September 29, 2014 meeting, was executed on October 1, 2014.

## **Old Town Hall Electric Rate Reduction**

Tim Curtin reported that Nancy Picicelli of the Engineering Department advised that she was able to switch Old Town Hall from a CL&P electric rate of 30, a medium commercial rate, to rate 25, a large commercial rate. The change will save Old Town Hall approximately \$168 per month in electric charges.
