THE MEETING BEGAN AT 6:30 PM

1. TED JANKOWSKI WAS UNABLE TO ATTEND THE MEETING. BOB STRADA AND MIKE PENSIERO DISCUSSED THE RESPONSE FROM THE COASTGUARD REGARDING TED JANKOWSKI'S LETTER IN REFERENCE TO THE LETTER FROM TOM YOUNG CONCERNING THE HURRICANE PLAN, SECTION OF PEOPLE REMAINING ON THEIR BOATS TO ADJUST LINES AS NEEDED DURING A STORM. THE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS HAVING A CONFERENCE CALL BETWEEN TED JANKOWSKI AND THE COASTGUARD TO CLAIRFY THE RESPONSE.
2. CONTINUED DISCUSSION ON THE CAMERAS IN THE HARBOR, HURRICANE BARRIER AND PROCEDURES ON HOW TO BEGIN THE PROCESS BEFORE THE GRANT MONEY DEADLINE.
3. THE COMMITTEE VOTED DISCUSSIONS REGARDING BARGES IN THE INNER HARBOR. SGT. MONCK DISCUSSED THE INCREASE IN THE WEST BRANCH WITH MORE TRANSIENT AND MORE SAFETY CONCERNS COMPARED TO THE EAST BRANCH. FURTHER CONVERSATION ON THE BARGES BEING RESTRICTED TO ONE AT A TIME IN THE INNER HARBOR DURING THE BOATING SEASON.
