## What is Household Hazardous Waste?

Virtually all households have some household hazardous waste (HHW). HHW is generally defined as a household waste that is toxic, flammable, reactive or corrosive.

### Common HHW includes:

Aerosol cans (not empty), Ammonia, Antifreeze, Arts and Crafts Supplies, Asbestos- (*Wet & Double Bagged in Plastic Bags*), Bleaches, Brake fluid, Cesspool cleaners, Creosote, Drain cleaners and openers, Dry cleaning fluids, Engine and radiator flushes and cleaners, Floor cleaners, Herbicides, FULL Household fire extinguishers, Insect sprays, Mercury thermometers, Metal polish, Moth balls, Muriatic acid, Old Chemistry Sets, Old Gasoline, Oven cleaners and Paint thinners, Pesticides, Photo Chemicals, Pool Chemicals, Rodent Killers, Rust Preventatives, Sealants, Solvents, Transmission Fluid, Wood Preservatives and Wood Strippers.

### Bring the following to the Recycling Center at 130 Magee Avenue:

Batteries, Fluorescent Light Bulbs, Motor Oil, EMPTY Aerosol Cans, Fire Extinguishers, Propane Tanks

### Bring the following to the Scale House 105 Harborview Avenue:

Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, and Tires
