

The purpose is

to increase public space in the downtown, provide high quality amenities such as seating or landscaping, and enhance the livability of the downtown. Parklets are small, but great places that can make a big impact. Parklets foster community simply by providing residents and visitors space to rest, interact, work, play, or create.



Participate

by designing, programming and activating a parking space! You can attract people to sit and relax in your parklet or you can host an activity like putt-putt, cornhole or board games! This program is offered at no cost, but participation requires approval by the City. Businesses or organizations may apply to this program by submitting the application attached with a description of the programming and design of the Parklet.



We will provide

your parking space with a meter bag on the morning of the event, on Friday, September 16th, to ensure that it is available for you to set up before the event begins. We will also provide traffic barricades for safety, and marketing materials to explain what Park(ing) day to passersby. You are responsible for operating your parklet on Friday, September 16th between 12:00 PM and 8:00 PM and cleaning up the parklet afterwards.

to Emily Provonsha at EProvonsha@stamfordct.gov or drop off a hard copy at the Transportation Bureau on the 7th floor of the Government Center, 888 Washington Blvd. Applications are due by August, 19th at 4:00 PM. The City will approve 10 applications for parklets this year.

Guidelines

1. Parklets may only utilize one (1) parking space.
2. Parklets cannot be located on streets exceeding a posted 25 mph.
3. Parklets must be located in front of the building or business operating it, unless arrangements are made with adjacent business or property owners.
4. All parklets must be located at least one parking space away from a corner, intersection, bus zone, driveway or curb cut.
5. All furniture and activities must be appropriate for public use for all ages and must not spill out into the street.
6. Activities such as soccer, basketball or volleyball are not permitted due to the risk of a ball flying out of the space and causing harm.
7. Noise must be at a reasonably low decible and considerate of surrounding uses.
8. If using electricity, participants must use light poles and tape down all cords.
9. The space cannot be used for commercial or advertising purposes.
10. The building or business must set up and take down the parklet between shortly before and after the duration of the event from 12:00-8:00PM.
