**Mayor to Promote MyStamford App, Participate in Inaugural
“Stamford Street Sweep”**

STAMFORD, CT – Mayor David Martin, as part of the Stamford Street Smart Initiative, will participate in the inaugural “Stamford Street Sweep” this Sunday beginning at 12:00 PM at Mill River Park. At the event, participants will walk and bike around the downtown and surrounding neighborhoods to utilize the City’s “MyStamford App” and report issues to City Hall. Issues ranging from potholes to missing street signage to graffiti can all be reported to the City through the app. At the conclusion of the event, participants will also provide feedback to the City on how to optimize the app moving forward.
