C. The Planning Board had specific questions for several Departments and is interested in hearing responses during the January 7th public hearing:

1. Stamford Center for the Arts should come back if they want to explain why there is a significant balance. Start listening at ~35 minutes.
Interior Finishes Palace Plaster was bidding during PB review and \$298,900 has since been awarded to John Canning. That is only for certain portions of plaster restoration and leaves a balance of ~\$100k. Next bid will be for other areas, estimated at ~\$250k. Jennifer is correct - restorations must be phased because of scope, schedule, and available funding. 39.5 mins.
2. Stamford museum. Start listening at ~37 minutes.
**Did you mean Scofield Manor at 37.5 mins? Scofield Manor Chiller and Room A/C units: Jennifer is correct - the \$355,000 is the updated estimate; previous was under by ~\$125k; there's zero balance, not \$200k unbonded, as stated by Chester.
SM&NC Site and Infrastructure Improvements: no, Ravi and Jennifer, their balance of \$90k is not "going to be spent down soon", as far as I see no bids in/out. 41 mins.**
3. Engineering Animal Shelter. Can this be phased?

6. Operations maintenance facilities. Please explain unfunded balance. ~55 min and 1 hr 21 min
CP3805 Heating System Replacement was for RTUs at Vehicle Maintenance, which was completed last year. New request lists 3 other site and notes that the \$500k balance is to be used at Yerwood. RTU bid awards came from CP9238 Yerwood CC Renovation.
7. The Planning Board would like someone to explain the various requests related to the Yearwood Center. If there was AARPA funding, that should be noted.
58 mins Roof Replacements City Wide CP6908 included Yerwood roof. Other Yerwood miscellaneous requests were made by Facilities.
8. Parks. Scalzi park. Some questions on partial funding. See 1 hour mark.
9. Public Safety Complex – At the capital budget meeting you noted a study to be complete in December. Is that available? 1:11 mark.
