Administrative & Operations Report: Patrol continues to address the quality of life issues. A lot of enforcement actions to where the senior reached out to express their gratitude. A lot of community cookouts happened. Patrol division focused on the scooters that have been a problem with traffic. Internet crimes division working diligently hard with cracking down with adults who are soliciting children for underage sex. The team also conducted a hostage rescue of an 8 and 11 year-old from a vehicle. The father had kidnapped the two children after assaulting his wife and one of the children in Newington, CT. No injuries reported/ outstanding job by the SRT.

Community Engagement: The Community Outreach Team with Pacific House and The Soup Kitchen have been addressing homelessness. Last month 6 individuals have opted to go back to their countries and 10 more have been identified and 3 of the 10 will also be going back volunteering.
