REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION

SUPPLEMENTAL CAPITAL PROJECT APPROPRIATION REQUESTS:

1. **STRAWBERRY HILL SOLAR PANEL PROJECT - PROJECT #CP4000055 - TOTAL AMOUNT REQUESTED \$150,000.00:** Funds will be utilized to complete the photovoltaic installation State Project 135-0292PV. Construction is scheduled to mobilize in June of 2026. This funding request is for construction administration services and construction contingency for potential unforeseen issues that may occur during construction. The request includes \$78,400.00 to proceed with Alternate 1 for a standalone solar tracking system component contributing to sustainable educational goals.
2. **WESTOVER SOLAR PANEL PROJECT - PROJECT #CP4000056 - TOTAL AMOUNT REQUESTED \$335,000.00:** Funds will be utilized to complete the photovoltaic installation of State Project #135-0293PV. Construction is scheduled to mobilize in June 2026. This funding request is for construction administration services and construction contingency for potential unforeseen issues that may occur during construction. The request includes \$125,000.00 to proceed with Alternate 1 for a standalone solar tracking system component to contribute to sustainable educational goals.

3. **CITYWIDE TECHNOLOGY REPLACEMENT & UPGRADE - PROJECT #C65201 - TOTAL AMOUNT REQUESTED \$186,400.00:** The City of Stamford is advancing a key digital equity initiative to expand free, high-speed public Wi-Fi at two major community hubs: the Lathon Wider Community Center and the Boys & Girls Club of Stamford. These sites serve thousands of South End and East Side residents annually, including many low-income, immigrant, and multilingual families who face significant barriers to affordable internet access. The project will extend and upgrade network infrastructure to provide reliable indoor and outdoor coverage at both locations, supporting remote learning, telehealth, workforce development, and other critical online services. Technical design and installation will be completed by qualified vendors, meeting the grant's requirement of one (1) gigabit-per-second symmetrical speeds. The City's Information Technology Department will oversee the project, with implementation support from the Stamford Partnership. This investment creates long-term, scalable public access points in trusted community spaces and represents a major step in closing Stamford's digital divide and improving opportunities for its most underserved residents.
