To the Stamford Planning Board Members,

As the president of Dolphin Cove, I represent a community of 104 homes whose community lies within 100 yards of Boccuzzi Park. We are urging members of the Board to secure the necessary funding to achieve what was envisioned over eight years ago for Boccuzzi Park.

We appreciate the progress that has been made, but we cannot stand by and watch continuous delays leave us with a half-finished project that has failed to deliver what we believe was a committed and funded project.

The Master Plan for renovation of Boccuzzi Park was completed in late 2017. We understand the disruptions caused by COVID, and the normal delays that come with infrastructure projects. However, after eight years, I believe the community should expect and deserve that its community leaders find a way to deliver on their commitments. Having the park as a perpetual construction site is unacceptable, especially as we have seen funding approved for other park projects.

We believe this investment in Boccuzzi Park and the associated recreational facilities supports the Town's emphasis on improving and enhancing the overall quality of life for its residents.

As you deliberate and review the 2026-27 Capital Budget and subsequent year Plan, please find the necessary funding to support the completion of the Boccuzzi Park development. Thank you for your consideration.
