### Old Business

- 1) Transportation, Traffic & Parking Department Updates
  - a. Progress to implement the Vision Zero Action Plan
    - i. Major Project Updates
      1. Bedford & Forest St. Pedestrian Plaza ongoing active construction
      2. Pacific Street (Raised intersections, raised crosswalks, bumpouts) wrapping up
      3. Sidewalk upgrades (Federally and locally funded)
        - Greenwich Ave
        - Hale St by K.T. Murphy Elementary
        - Crestview & Hague for new city playground
      4. 2026 construction schedule to be formatted by next meeting
    - ii. Vision Zero Road Safety Awareness Educational Campaign
      1. Contracted with media & PR firm to develop a roadway safety campaign for VZ, still in development
        - Society-wide, public health angle
        - Short-form videos
        - Bus shelter, news publication ads
        - Expected rollout Summer 2026
    - iii. Speed Safety Cameras
      1. 14 cameras officially approved by CTDOT,
      2. Operator contract will be voted on by BOR at their next meeting, passed by Transportation committee, Board of Finance
      3. Goal to install before 2026-27 school year
      4. 7 school sites to be installed
        - Tom's Road by Dolan Middle School
        - Glenbrook Road by Stark Elementary
        - W. North St. by Cloonan Middle & Hart Elementary
        - Strawberry Hill Ave by Stamford High School & Strawberry Hill Elementary
        - Cove Rd by K.T. Murphy



- iv. Bus Shelters
  1. CTTransit & CTDOT went around to all their districts and looked for opportunities to upgrade bus shelters, especially in high ridership/key locations along their routes (i.e. Stamford)
  2. Entirely state-funded, all sites have been selected
  3. The City inspected sites with CTTransit & CTDOT to help pick sites
  4. Bus shelter upgrades (EOY 2026)
    - Phase 1 - 10 bus shelters around Stamford upgraded with new shelters and landing pads
    - Phase 2 – 18 shelters upgraded
    - 28 shelters total by end of year
    - Determined by the State and under environmental review
  5. A few sites will not be upgraded due to size constraints
  6. Difficulties with timelines from Eversource, property easements have delayed installation
  7. Some stops removed, replaced with others from CTDOT's list
  8. Rollout to be included along with construction schedule coming this summer
  9. All of the shelters will be maintained by the City's Transit District once installed
- v. Reviewing corner parking restriction signs in East Side and Cove
  1. City is currently drafting a comprehensive plan for the Cove and East Side neighborhoods
  2. Daylighting, illegal parking on corners complaints from residents will be addressed
  3. Intern has been assessing signage across East Side and Cove
  4. Parking sign improvement will be considered for inclusion in Cove & East Side Neighborhood Plan
- vi. Crosswalk re-stripping plans for 2026
  1. List of city-owned streets where streets have not been striped diligently
  2. Focusing on high pedestrian locations (schools and parks)
  3. 10-15% of the list completed in 2025 (List was created partway through 2025)
  4. Parks will be restriped leading up to summer when the weather warms
  5. In the lead of up to 2026-27 school year, crosswalk restriping will take place.

## 2) Police Department/Public Safety Updates



- a. Crash data has all been compiled
- b. 3 fatal pedestrian crashes in 2025, 62% decrease from year prior
- c. Trying to increase manpower in police traffic unit by 1 officer
- d. Traffic Safety Day at Police Department, there was talk about this last year but would like to be attempted this year
