

Notice of Permit Application

Municipality: Stamford, CT

Notice is hereby given that City Recycling LLC (the “applicant”) of 90 Arboretum Drive, Suite 300, Portsmouth, NH has submitted to the Department of Energy & Environmental Protection an application under section 22a-208a of the Connecticut General Statutes for a permit to conduct a regulated activity in the construction, alteration or operation of solid waste facilities.

Specifically, the applicant proposes to renew the current Permit to Construct and Operate 13501168-M/PO & 13501168-2021RMPCO with no changes to the total processing and storage capacity. The renewal will include the acceptance and processing of previously permitted types of solid waste including: (a) putrescible MSW; (b) commingled recyclable items; (c) cardboard; (d) paper; (e) plastic; scrap metal, including appliances with CFC liquid; (f), clean wood; (g) scrap tires; and (h) universal waste. The proposed activity will take place at 61 Taylor Reed Place in Stamford, CT. The current activities could potentially affect the Noroton River.
